You know that dream where you're on stage in front of an audience, with absolutely no idea what you're supposed to be doing? Welcome to the opening night of Stuart's show.

Forced by his mother to give a performed biography of his life at the Fringe, Stuart just wants to go home. Contending with meddling from the winds, a technician who falls asleep and his own open wounds, what was meant to be a whimsical trip down memory lane turns into a real-time, real life nightmare.


This one-man-play-within-a-play is the doomed debut of Stuart's show, where anything that can go wrong inevitably will. With character comedy and blindsiding plot twists at its heart, the play is a fast paced rollercoaster of emotions.

Innocent, naive and hopelessly likeable, Stuart will inevitably leave his audience with broken hearts as they come to learn his journey from childhood to this stage. Betrayed by the love of his life and blinkered by the pain, Stuart strolls straight into a trap. Will simply retelling this tale prove all too much? Will he even make it to the end of the play?

Mischief Theatre meets Philip Ridley - it's a riot of fun ending with a sucker-punch to the gut that will make you question yourself for laughing in the first place.

An Audience With Stuart Bagcliffe is the second play from Triptych Theatre. Sally, Michael and Benny formed the company in 2014 in their last year at East 15 Acting School. Benny acts as writer, actor and co-producer while Sally and Michael act as directors, actors, and co-producers. Every aspect of their shows are created and realised by their small but mighty troupe of three. Benny began writing this at the 2014 Edinburgh Fringe, and took nearly four years to finish the first draft. Inspired by some of the work he saw that year, and articles about the illegal organ trade overseas, this is a coming of age story exploring themes of love, trauma, mental health and betrayal.


