She then followed this up with *Dreams*, an hour of stand-up and musical comedy about the future, and *Saturn Return lol*, a hilarious investigation into the phenomena of major life changes occurring every 29.5 years in connection with this astrological event.

Jordan has also supported comedians Hannah Gadsby and Catherine Cohen, and has toured Australia as part of the MICF Roadshow. She is an in-demand writer, participating in numerous development rooms, working as a contributor on CJZ show *Question Everything* and is currently writing on Adam Hills' *Spicks and Specks*.
